MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT – Jo Karr Tedder

In 2020 & 2021, CTWC developed our educational Luv the Lakes outreach program, as well as strengthened our legislative agenda. In 2021 and 2022, we hosted Water Roundtables in both the Lake Travis and Lake Buchanan regions for elected officials. Our first Business Water Roundtable held January 2023 was so successful that we had to close registration at 100 participants. We will be holding additional Water Roundtables for both groups. We continue to monitor LCRA and Region K (TWDB) by attending meetings and submitting comments on agenda items, rules, and procedures, posted on our website. We still have work to do to protect our lakes, the local economy, and the water supply for Central Texas. We could find ourselves in a worse situation than 2008-2015 given the rapid population growth, drastically low inflows, La Nina, and the continuation of drought. With your support, we will make certain that the voice of everyone who lives, works, or relies on the lakes for water is heard when it comes to improving the management policies and releases of the water supply from the lakes. **Water is our future. Please help us protect it.**
